Our outputs

Participants host their first live concert, create their first portfolio of professional media published by Lo-Fi and establish international mentor and collaborator relationships crucial to development as a professional artists in their medium

Students graduate with an AA as they move on to explore a career in arts education, transfer to a traditional university or continue their lives abroad as multilingual citizen artists

Participants receive a 120-hour online Master TEFL certification course with a concentration in arts-integrated curriculum design and a capstone multimedia project for their teaching portfolios
